Index to WHRG circulars

The Waterways History Research Group (WHRG) circulates five types of members' contributions: Notes and Queries, Occasional Papers, Photograph Queries, Reprints, and Sources Papers. Notes and Queries are generally shorter pieces, describing the results of research or requesting information about a particular topic. Additional information or answers to queries are added as they become available. Occasional Papers are longer, giving more extensive results of work in progress or rehearsing papers prior to their being offered for publication elsewhere. Photograph Queries are requests for information about photographs whose location, date or other facts are not known. Reprints are copies of articles or the like that have appeared in other publications, particularly those that a waterways historian might not ordinarily expect to access, and which might inspire further research. Sources Papers describe the contents of sources useful to waterways historians, though not to duplicate the increasing availability of online catalogues.

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
